As a result, CentOS Linux users must migrate to a new operating system (OS) to continue receiving updates, patches, and new features. While implementing a new OS may seem tedious, it also presents an opportunity to reassess your organization's needs and choose a platform that will better support your business and IT strategies now and in the future.

Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Third Party Linux Migration is a set of competitively priced subscription offerings for current CentOS Linux 7 users. All of these offerings include access to:

 consistent, intelligent operating foundation for modern IT and enterprise hybrid cloud deployments.
- High availability (HA). Deploy managed, highly available clusters of Red Hat Enterprise Linux systems to deliver reliability, scalability, and availability to your critical production services.
- ▶ Convert2RHEL tool. Convert your CentOS Linux 7 systems to Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7 systems in-place. Using Convert2RHEL keeps your existing customizations, configurations, preferences, and results in a supported instance of Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7. This tool works with RPM-based Linux distributions and is fully supported for conversions from CentOS Linux and Oracle Linux.

Organizations that need more time to plan and upgrade to Red Hat Enterprise Linux 8 or 9 post-conversion can take advantage of the Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Third Party Linux Migration with Extended Life Cycle Support offerings. The 2 offerings include **4 years of Extended Life Cycle**Support (ELS) with access to Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7 security patches and updates until June 2028.

Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Third Party Linux Migration offerings will be available for on-site datacenter deployments and on Amazon Web Services (AWS), Microsoft Azure, and Google Cloud via cloud provider marketplaces and Red Hat Cloud Access.

It converts your CentOS Linux 7 systems in-place-both in on-site datacenters and in cloud environments-while preserving your configurations and settings. With Convert2RHEL, there is no need to tear down or redeploy your application stack, minimizing disruptions to your operations.

Finally, if you migrate from CentOS Linux 7 to Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7 by June 2024, but need more time to upgrade to a later version of Red Hat Enterprise Linux, you can take advantage of the 4 years of patches and updates included with the Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Third Party Linux Migration with ELS offerings, both in your own datacenter or in public cloud environments.
